Bucharest is the capital city, cultural, industrial, and financial centre of Romania. Bucharest was first mentioned in documents as early as 1459. Since then it has gone through a variety of changes, becoming the state capital of Romania in 1859 and steadily consolidating its position as the centre of the Romanian mass media, culture and arts. Its eclectic architecture is a mix of historical (neo-classical), interbellum (Bauhaus and Art Deco), Communist-era and modern. In the period between the two World Wars, the city's elegant architecture and the sophistication of its elite earned Bucharest the nickname of the "Little Paris of the East".

The 39th International Congress of the Romanian Society of Neurosurgery will be held in the emblematic edifice of the National Military Center.

The National Military Center is a building from Bucharest hosting the central cultural institution of the Romanian army. Its interior is grand and throughout time hosted balls, reunions, and nowadays painting exhibitions, sculpture expositions, and book launchings. The Palace's halls are: The Marble Hall, The Moor Hall, The Byzantine Hall, the Gothic Hall and the Norwegian Hall.
